PRELIMINARY CONSTRUCTION FOR
MUSC ROADWAY INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

In preparation for the upcoming Charleston County RoadWise MUSC Roadway Infrastructure Improvements Project, South Carolina Electric & Gas and Anson Construction Company will be closing **ONE BLOCK OF BEE STREET**, between Lockwood Drive and Cherry Street, to install new underground electrical duct banks.

The street closure for this block is scheduled to begin on Monday, February 1, 2010 at 9:00 AM and will end no later than Thursday, February 11, 2010. Due to the extensive nature of the work, this section of Bee Street will be blocked 24 hours a day for the duration of the closure.

Motorists needing to reach the rest of Bee Street are advised to use the following routes to access Bee Street:

- Traffic coming from West Ashley should continue on Highway 17 North and turn right at Cherry Street or Courtenay Drive.
- Traffic coming from Mount Pleasant is encouraged to use the Rutledge Avenue exit from the Crosstown (Septima P. Clark Parkway), taking a right onto Bee Street.

Detour routes will be marked. Motorists are asked to use caution and be patient as they travel through the detour routes.
