Councilmember Gallant Receives NLC Leadership Training Honor

Charleston, SC. Councilmember Jimmy Gallant was recognized by the National League of Cities (NLC) for reaching the Platinum level in its Certificate of Achievement in Leadership program. Sponsored by the NLC Leadership Training Institute (LTI), the award was presented in Washington, DC at the annual Congressional City Conference on March 14, 2010.

The Leadership Training Institute provides local officials with the professional development opportunities to assist them in promoting positive change within their communities. The seminars are designed to explore the nature and practice of local government leadership.

To achieve the Platinum level, a local official must earn 50 credits encompassing all five core competency areas of the LTI curriculum, referred to as "Cornerstone," "Competent Practitioner," "Communicator," "Collaborator" and "Catalyst."

Each training seminar addresses one or more of the core areas of municipal leadership, including personal leadership growth and development, effective governance, effective communication, skills in developing and promoting partnerships and managing change.

Mayor Joseph P. Riley, Jr. said, "It is a real accomplishment for Councilmember Gallant to have received the National League of Cities leadership training award. I am so proud of the time and hard work Councilmember Gallant put into this honor and I know that the residents of the City of Charleston are proud as well."
