A N O R D I N A N C E

TO AMEND CHAPTER 17 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF CHARLESTON, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO MODIFY THE CITY'S PALMETTO ARTISAN REGULATIONS TO EXTEND THE AGE OF THE PROGRAM TO EIGHTEEN YEARS OLD OR UNTIL GRADUATION FROM HIGH SCHOOL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS IN CITY COUNCIL ASSEMBLED:

Section 1. Chapter 17, Section 92, of the Code of the City of Charleston is hereby amended by deleting the below stricken language and replacing it with the following underlined words and phrases which shall read as follows:

“Sec. 17-92. Definitions.

City of Charleston's Youth Palmetto Art and Business Program shall mean the program, administered by the City of Charleston's Recreation Department, for youths between the ages of nine (9) and ~~sixteen (16)~~ eighteen (18) or the completion of high school, whichever occurs first, for the purposes of teaching youth entrepreneurial skills using palmetto art products.

Palmetto artisan shall mean any person who is enrolled in the City of Charleston's Youth Palmetto Art and Business Program, who are traveling by foot or any type of conveyance, from place to place, house to house, or from street to street, attempting to sell palmetto bud fronds that have been physically altered from their natural state into a palmetto art product. Individuals, who are eighteen or older and not in over the age of seventeen (17) high school, that are selling palmetto art products shall be considered peddlers for the purpose of this chapter.

Section 2. Chapter 17, Section 109, of the Code of the City of Charleston is hereby amended by deleting the below stricken language and replacing it with the following underlined words and phrases which shall read as follows:

“Sec. 17-109. Palmetto Artisan Permit—required.

(1) No person between the ages of nine (9) and ~~seventeen (17)~~ eighteen (18), unless still enrolled in high school, shall engage in the selling of palmetto art products within the corporate limits of the city without first obtaining a palmetto artisan permit in compliance with the provisions of this article and the rules and regulations of the City of Charleston's Youth Palmetto Art and Business Program. Copies of the program rules and regulations shall be made available to the public by the city's recreation department. Individuals over the age of eighteen (18) who are not still in high school ~~seventeen (17)~~ who sell palmetto art products shall be considered peddlers for the purposes of this chapter.

(3) **Investigation of Palmetto Artisan Applicant; issuance.**

Investigation of palmetto artisan applicant; issuance. The Recreation Department in conjunction with the Charleston Police Department shall issue a palmetto artisan's permit within fourteen (14) days as provided for hereunder when, from a consideration of the application and from such other information as may otherwise be obtained, they find that:

- a) The applicant has not had a permit suspended or revoked within the twelve (12) months immediately preceding the date of the application for a permit.
- b) There are no material omissions, untrue or misleading information contained in or omitted from the permit application;
- c) The applicant is between the ages of nine (9) and seventeen (17) or is eighteen (18) and still in high school;
- d) The applicant has successfully completed the City of Charleston's Youth Palmetto Art and Business Program orientation;
- e) The applicant has not received six or more Palmetto Artisan Program Violations in the past 12 months.
- f) The applicant has not been convicted of a felony or a misdemeanor involving a sex offense, controlled substances, or any violent acts against person or property;
- g) There are no warrants outstanding against the applicant; and,
- h) The applicant's parent or guardian has signed the application."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon ratification by City Council.
