Throughout the year, members will have the opportunity to participate in leadership training, team-building activities and community service events.

**Membership details:** The Commission convenes monthly, typically in the evening. Some meetings will be held virtually and others will take place in-person.

Once accepted, members will serve a term lasting from March 2023 to May 2024.
