City of Charleston and State of South Carolina to Host Flood Mitigation & Assistance Presentations

Charleston, S.C.—Representatives from the city of Charleston and state of South Carolina will host a series of presentations for residents on flood mitigation and assistance on Thursday, February 8, 2018. The first presentation will take place at Bees Landing Recreation Center (1580 Ashley Gardens Boulevard) at 3 p.m., and the second in the Charleston Museum Auditorium (360 Meeting Street) at 6 p.m.

The presentations will include an overview of the different types of Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) grants related to flooding, information on FEMA's National Flood Insurance Program, as well as an update on the city's progress and future plans.
