Bees Landing Recreation Center to Temporarily Close as COVID-19 Precaution

Charleston, S.C.—Earlier today, the city of Charleston Recreation Department learned of one employee at Bees Landing Recreation Center who has tested positive for COVID-19. While the employee has not been in the workplace since Tuesday of last week, the facility has closed and will remain closed throughout the coming week to allow for thorough disinfecting.

The employee has self-quarantined, and the city is conducting a thorough contact tracing effort to determine if additional employees will require testing before being allowed to return to work.

The city of Charleston's other pools and summer day camps are not affected by this temporary closure and will continue to operate normally.
