**“TREES TO OFFSET WATER”-  $Trees_2O H_2O$**

Charleston is nearing completion on a study about beneficially integrating trees into the City’s stormwater mgmt. programs.

Trees improve air quality, provide shade, decrease erosion, remove pollutants from stormwater, and can soak up a tremendous volume of stormwater. The South Carolina Forestry Commission is studying Charleston to see if we can use more trees to help us reduce flooding and improve water quality in our lakes, wetlands, springs, and rivers. The study is culminating soon and your input on draft recommendations is vital.
