

# Late Night Establishment (LNE)

## PERMITTING PROCESS OVERVIEW

### LNE DEFINITION

#### LNE's are defined as businesses that:

- Are licensed to allow on-premises consumption of beer, wine, or alcohol
- Are not located within a building that also provides accommodations uses (i.e., hotel or inn) with a minimum of 20 rooms
- Are open to the public after midnight
- Are required to have a Class 8.4 (formerly 7a or 7b) business license

If located within 500 feet of a residential zoning district

LATE NIGHT USE SPECIAL EXEMPTION

Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA-Z)  
Allow 45 days for review

IF APPROVED:  
Apply for LNE Permit & BLCO

Not located within 500 feet of a residential zoning district

LATE NIGHT ENTERTAINMENT (LNE) PERMIT

LNE Committee  
Allow 30 days for review

NOTE: These can be done concurrently, however, a BLCO will not be granted until the LNE PERMIT has been processed.

BUSINESS LICENSE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY (BLCO)

Permit Center  
Allow 30 days for review
