SIMPLE WAYS TO RAINPROOF A HOME OR OFFICE YARD

1. Install a Rain Garden
2. Collect Water in a Rain Barrel
3. Plant a Tree
4. Use Native Plants



RAIN GARDENS

A landscaped depression full of water-loving plants that infiltrates excess rainwater into the ground.

RAINWATER HARVESTING SYSTEMS

Capture rainwater for reuse, such as for watering plants, in a rain barrel or cistern.

Combine them! Send rain barrel overflow into a rain garden.

TREES

Did you know one mature tree can store 50 to 100 gallons of water during a storm? Species selection and location are really important for a successful tree planting, our resources online can guide you!



NATIVE PLANTS

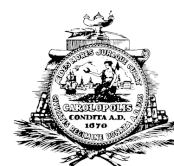
Native plants have deep roots which help water infiltrate into the soil; native plants also support a healthy local ecology.
