


# Daniel Island

Daniel Island is a 4,000 acre island located in the City of Charleston. Named after its former inhabitant, the colonial governor of the Carolinas, Robert Daniell, the island is located in Berkeley County and situated between the Cooper and Wando Rivers. Residents of Daniel Island enjoy all the conveniences of modern living in a spectacular waterfront setting. The community offers a pedestrian-friendly downtown, charming neighborhoods, and hundreds of acres of parks & green space. Daniel Island is also home to the newly renovated CreditOne Stadium which brings world class athletes and entertainment to the Island.

The Daniel Island Neighborhood Association (DINA), established in 1998, has actively participated in the growth of the community, evolving itself along the way. DINA represents all residents, not just property owners. DINA membership is free. However, the Board has established voluntary dues for residents to support DINA financially since there is otherwise no funding source for the Association.



2022 has been a year of rebuilding DINA through communication, visibility and engagement. DINA conducted a Resident Survey earlier this year to inform its priorities and work for the neighborhood. Traffic and Development were the top priorities identified by residents who participated in the survey. DINA regularly attends community events and has partnered with CreditOne Stadium to give away free concert tickets to our members.

Numerous committees have been created to focus on areas of interest and community concern. A new website [www.DINeighborhood.org](http://www.DINeighborhood.org) was launched for residents to easily access information about DINA meetings, events, committees, results of the Resident Survey, as well as sharing input or reaching the DINA Board and Committee Chairs. DINA Facebook and Instagram pages are also used to share information with residents.
