

Late Night Entertainment Establishment (LNE)

PERMITTING PROCESS OVERVIEW

LNE DEFINITION

Late Night Establishment (LNE) means:

Any bar, restaurant, venue, or commercial establishment, that currently allows on-premises consumption of beer, wine, or alcohol, and remains **open after midnight** located within the city. This includes hotel accommodations.



If located within 500 feet of a residential zoning district

Not located within 500 feet of a residential zoning district



LATE NIGHT USE SPECIAL EXEMPTION

Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA-Z)
Allow 45 days for review

LATE NIGHT ENTERTAINMENT (LNE) PERMIT

Customer Self Service (CSS) Portal
Allow 6 days for review

BUSINESS LICENSE CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY (BLCO)

Permit Center
Allow 30 days for review

Apply for LNE Permit & BLCO

NOTE: These can be done concurrently, however, a BLCO will not be granted until the LNE PERMIT has been processed.
