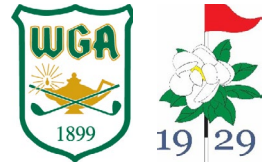

# Requirements of a Caddie

Charleston Municipal Golf Course Youth Caddie Program



As a Caddie you will learn the necessary skills to help support your golfer during their round. Here are the general requirements of a Caddie:

- Watch where your player's ball is at all times; mark its position.
- Keep your golfers clubs clean, dry and safe.
- Replace all divots.
- Rake all bunkers.
- Walk ahead or even with your player, but never behind.
- Be extremely careful around the putting green. Never stand in a player's imaginary line starting at the ball and finishing at the hole.
- Help your golfer determine yardage to the pin by learning the yardages for each hole, especially where the 150-yard marker is.
- Never touch a golf ball while it is in play.
- Remain quiet during all players' shots, hustle and of course do not know be afraid to ask what to do if you are not sure.
- Over time watch and learn the game and rules of golf including how each of the 14 clubs are used.

**A base caddie fee of \$40 and lunch will be provided by the Western Golf Association. The WGA asks golfers to tip for good service. (Recommended tip for a good job for 18 holes is \$20).**

# Chick Evans Scholarships

## Full Tuition and Housing College Scholarships for Caddies



The Evans Scholarship is a full tuition and housing college scholarship awarded to high-achieving golf caddies with limited financial means. The estimated value of a four-year Evans Scholarship is \$125,000. Evans Scholars are enrolled at 22 leading universities nationwide.

### Evans Scholarship Criteria

To qualify, caddies must be nominated by their club and meet four requirements:

#### Strong Caddie Record

- Minimum, two years active
- Average Evans recipient in 2022, 3-4 years of service
- Average Evans recipient in 2022, 165 loops

#### Excellent Academics

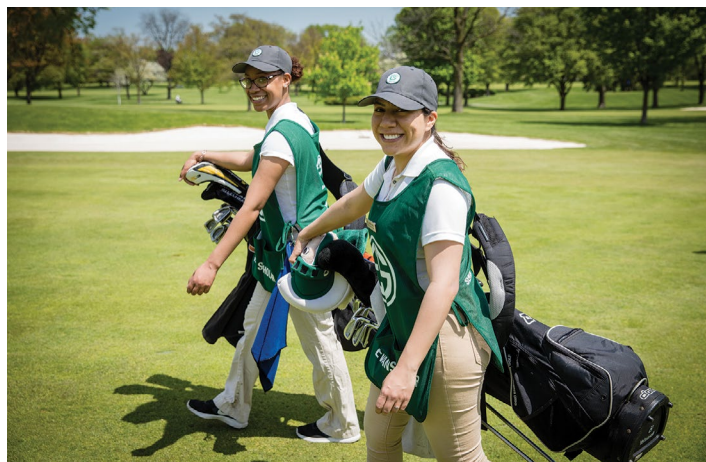
- Recipients national average unweighted 3.7 cumulative GPA
- Recipients national average 27-28 ACT and/or 1250 SAT

#### Demonstrated Financial Need

- Target annual household income, less than \$100,000
- Average combined household income in 2022 for recipients was \$67,000

#### Outstanding Character

- Activities, Volunteering, Athletics
